It was a very great pleasure to talk to you in the studio. I hope that it was part of an enjoyable stay in New York. I was delighted that you have found my painting. I am sure that restoration will not be a very difficult undertaking.

I have enclosed photographs of two recent projects. One is for a museum. It is in the form of two intersecting leaf shapes. The shapes follow a waved outline to form the roof. The exterior walls are described by extending perpendicular lines from the edge of the waved roof. The photographs show the museum passing through three stages of development.

The other project is a sculptural monument or memorial in the form of a building. It is a structure that people can walk around and through, yet open and generous enough to invite contemplation and reflection.
